

Allergy, Dermatology, and Otology

<u>Step 2</u> 90% Effective and Very Safe and (moderately expensive)

Give Atopica/Cyclavance/Cyclosporine every 24 hours to control/prevent symptoms OK to mix in yummy food or with yummy chaser

<u>Step 3</u> 95% Effective but with Adverse Effects (inexpensive)

Give ORAL Dex tablets or liquid

If Severe symptoms - Give every day for 3-5 days then reduce

If Mild symptoms or to prevent symptoms - Give every 2-3 days

Consider Injectable Dex SP

If Severe symptoms - Give every day for 3-5 days then reduce

If Mild symptoms or to prevent symptoms - Give every 2-3 days

<u>Step 4</u> 65% Effective and Very Safe (moderately expensive)

Regional Allergy Vaccine based on the patients Zip code with he most common allergens. This is added to above treatments to reduce the amount and dose of the other medications.

Weekly injection with the Allergy Vaccine Shots

Step 5 - 11 WAIT ON THESE

Amitryptyline every 12 hours Apoquel every 12 - 24 hours Allergy Skin Testing Home-Cooked diet restriction Skin Biopsies Metabolic Blood Lab-Work Abdominal Ultrasound for Para-neoplastic Dermatitis
