## Feline Skin Disease:

## Make sure there are no symptoms typical of Classic Dermatosis:

Herpes Virus/Shingles Dermatitis - Bloody Face Syndrome Swiss Cheese Draining Sores - Deep Bacterial/Fungal infection Kittens or Shelter cats - Dermatophyte/Ringworm Cats starting OLDER than 10 yrs - Para-Neoplastic Dermatitis Sores around the mammary-chain - Auto-Immune (Lupus/Pemphigus)

## All other Patterns and Symptoms are Feline Atopic Allergy syndrome:

Focal crusts on the body - Miliary Dermatitis Head & Neck Sores Dermatitis Bald-Belly legs or Back - Allergic Alopecia Hair-loss and crusts on the arms - Mural Folliculitis Ulcers on the upper lip - Indolent Rodent Ulcers Swollen Chin - Fat Chin Syndrome Mouth or Gum sores - Stomatitis Eosinophilic Plaques or Granulomas

 Feline Atopic Allergy Syndrome can be caused and triggered by many allergens: Insects/Mites/Mosquitoes/Fleas + Pollens/Molds + Foods
We will progress through the treatment steps every 3 weeks to find the SAFEST + MOST EFFECTIVE + COST EFFECTIVE treatment that the cat tolerates.

**<u>Step 1</u>** 60% Effective and Very Safe (inexpensive)

Apply <u>**Revolution PLUS**</u> every 30 days as the best treatment and prevention for insects/mites/mosquitoes/fleas (must be **PLUS** product)

If tolerated - Apply Genesis Liquid every 12-24 hours and allow 5 min to dry

**Chlorpheniramine** 4mg tablets Give 1/2 tablet every 12 hours or 1 tablet every 24 hours to prevent symptoms
